

SEVERE WEATHER WARNING SIRENS

THERE ARE BASICALLY TWO TYPES OF WARNINGS:

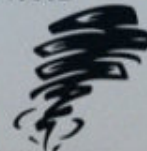
1. Three Minute Steady Blast

- A Tornado or severe storm warning has been received from a reliable source, such as the Sheriff's Department or the National Weather Service, and will pass through our area.
- **WARNING MEANS:** The storm has the ability to produce damaging winds/hail/flash flooding/tornadoes.
- **PRECAUTIONS:** Take measures to protect life and property. Tune Radio to local stations for information.

2. Three Minute Steady Blast followed by Three Minute Blast Up and Down

- A Tornado has been sighted in the area.
- **PRECAUTIONS:** Take immediate cover/listen to radio.
- When in doubt of sirens of weather/tune into the radio or local station for advice.
